Case Western Reserve University has offered C TSA Convention participants the option of lodging in the **Village 115** complex, which offers a wide range of modern amenities. Apartment-style suites include plasma TVs in each lounge, and wireless internet access is also available. Rooms in the village offer double beds and air conditioning, and each unit includes full kitchen accommodations, private bath and shower. COST:

Lodging per night	\$55.00
ID card – one- time fee	\$15.00
Linens – one-time fee (optional)	\$20.00
Parking - one- time fee (optional)	\$17.50

Total cost, including linens and car, is \$72.50 per night, if staying for three nights.

The campus is easily accessible from the Tower City Rapid station, on the RTA's Healthline bus, which runs every 15 minutes or more frequently until 11 pm. After that, service runs about every half hour. There is a stop at E. 115th St. It is recommended that you not travel alone late at night, especially with a suitcase! CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT

Guests residing the Village 115 register at Wade Commons, located on East 115th Street, one and a half blocks north of Euclid Avenue. Summer office hours are:

Monday - Friday: 8 a.m. - 9 p.m.; Saturday & Sunday: 10 a.m. - 9 p.m.

If you are unable to check in or check out during regular hours, contact the registration office at 216.368.1026, or e-mail guesthousing@case.edu to make alternate arrangements.

- Guests will receive a key/key card to their room and a university ID card to access exterior doors to their facility.
- Guests must pay in full for their room charges. Payment may be made with cash, credit card, travelers' checks, personal checks, or money orders, unless billed to a Case account.
- Guests must present a valid form of picture identification.
- Any outstanding charges must be paid at check-out time.
- If keys or ID cards are not returned, replacement charges will be assessed (\$85/key and \$25/ID).
